ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (November 18, 2011) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures and possible delays today, Friday, November 18, 2011, due to construction and maintenance projects:

- City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have the westbound lane of Nansemond Parkway closed between Helen Street and Dayle Acres as well as between Shoulder's Hill Road west to the railroad tracks. Flaggers will be in place from 8 a.m. until 4 p.m.

-City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a lane shift on Sleepy Hole Road between Nansemond Parkway and the 3300 block of Sleepy Hole Road from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

-City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagger operation on Kings Highway between Crittenden Road and Ciara Estates until 1:00 p.m.

-A contractor will have a milling and resurfacing project on Whaleyville Boulevard between Babbtown Road and Greenway Road from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. each day. A flagger operation with alternating, single lane closures throughout the work zone will be used to control traffic. Delays are possible.

-A construction company will have a flagger operation with single lane closure in 5200 block of Godwin Boulevard from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

-City of Suffolk Department of Public Utilities will clean sewer lines at the 700 block of North Main Street. The southbound right lane will be closed to traffic from 9:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. Traffic will be directed to merge over to the southbound passing lane until the cleaning is complete.
