ROAD CLOSURES AND POSSIBLE TRAFFIC DELAYS

SUFFOLK, VA (December 2, 2011) The following roads in the City of Suffolk will have closures and possible delays today, Friday, December 2, 2011, due to construction and maintenance projects:

-City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagger operation on Godwin Boulevard between Everets Road and Kings Highway until 2:30 p.m.

-A contractor will have a flagger operation with single lane closure at the 5200 block of Godwin Boulevard from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m.

-A contractor will have a flagger operation on Sleepy Hole Road between Kings Highway and Bennett's Pasture Road from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

-A contractor will have a milling and paving operation on Whaleyville Boulevard between Babbtown Road and Greenway Road from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. A flagger operation with alternating single lane closures will be utilized to control traffic. Delays are possible.

-City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagger operation north of the entrance to Paul D. Camp Community College on Kenyon Road and north of the railroad crossing from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. The northbound lane will be closed during this time. The speed limit will be reduced to 25 mph for the entire length of Kenyon Road in both directions.

-City of Suffolk Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering Division will have a short term stationary work zone at the intersection of Main Street and Farm Fresh, 1400 block, affecting the southbound traffic on Main Street and the right turn lane coming out of Farm Fresh from 9:00 a.m. until 12 p.m. This work is to install overhead traffic control devices.

-City of Suffolk Department of Public Works will have a flagger operation in the 2600 block of Manning Road from 9:00 a.m. until 12 p.m.
